

CORE BELIEFS – the most basic truths about our organization, shared by all stakeholders and guiding all action

VISION - what the world would look like if our beliefs were fully realized... our preferred future

MISSION - describes our central purpose, our reason to exist as a learning organization

OPERATIONAL GOALS – statements that define the duties of the District within our five broad areas of work

TARGETED OBJECTIVES – specific targets within each operational goal which can be measured over time through a summative process based on the success of multiple strategies over the course of the four-year plan

STRATEGIES – strategic action items that fulfill the work of the targeted objectives and are measured both formatively and summatively
