Traffic Signal Approved for Intersection of SH377 and Bobcat Blvd.

Northwest ISD has received the following information from Denton County Commissioner Andy Eads:

Denton County Commissioner Andy Eads is proud to announce a major improvement for the intersection of Bobcat Blvd and US Highway 377. After several years of traffic studies, negotiations, and many meetings with key TxDOT personnel, a traffic signal has been approved to be installed at the intersection of Highway 377 and Bobcat Blvd to aid the flow of traffic and add safety to the residents travelling in southwest Denton County and particularly to and from Byron Nelson High School.

“The safety of our students is our first priority,” said Byron Nelson High School Principal Linda Parker. “As the community continues to grow, this will ensure safety for our families and young drivers as traffic increases.”

TxDOT will begin acquiring materials for construction in March. The signal is expected to be constructed and fully operational by summer 2012, just in time for the start of school in August.
