NISD High School Student Wins Chevy Camaro, 24 Others Win Dell Inspiron Laptops

More than 4,100 Northwest ISD high school students packed the stands at Texas Motor Speedway as IndyCar Driver of the #27 Team GoDaddy.com Chevrolet, James Hinchcliffe presented Northwest High School freshman Matt Boyd with keys to the 2012 Chevy Camaro at the Northwest ISD Strive N Drive Car Giveaway on Monday, May 21. Boyd's ticket was one of 25 drawn from the hopper. Students had earned tickets throughout the year for academic success and good attendance.

From the 237,811 tickets issued, 3,936 students qualified for the drawing. Newark resident and winner of the 2012 Chevrolet Camaro, Matt Boyd, was the 14th student to try his key to unlock the car. After unlocking the door to his new car, IndyCar Driver James Hinchcliffe took Boyd and his older brother on a victory lap around the Texas Motor Speedway track.
