NISD Announces Principal of Chisholm Trail Middle School

At the December 12 School Board meeting, Todd Rogers was announced as the new principal of Northwest ISD's Chisholm Trail Middle School in Rhome.

"I am looking forward to continuing the strong educational foundation and sense of community pride that has been established at Chisholm Trail Middle School," Rogers said. "Together we will continue the success and achievement that has made CTMS a Texas 'School to Watch'."

Rogers is currently the principal at Northwest ISD's O.A. Peterson Elementary in Fort Worth where he has led the campus since its opening in 2008. Prior to his career in Northwest ISD, Rogers was principal at Rann Elementary in Decatur ISD and served as an assistant principal at Grapevine High School in Grapevine-Colleyville ISD.

"Todd's energy and proven leadership skills have made him a successful instructional leader in Northwest ISD," said Superintendent Karen G. Rue, Ed.D. "The Chisholm Trail Middle School community is getting an innovative, hard-working new team member – a leader who will maintain the pride and traditions at CTMS."

Rogers graduated with a bachelor's degree from Salisbury State University, and earned his masters of education and administration from the University of North Texas. In 2008, he received his Superintendent Certification and is working toward his doctorate of educational leadership from NOVA Southeastern University. Rogers is also certified through the National Institute for School Leadership (NISL).

He replaces Rob Thornell, Ed.D., who was recently named Northwest ISD's new executive director for staff development and curriculum. Rogers will transition into his new role and will begin full-time as soon as his successor at Peterson Elementary School is hired.
