

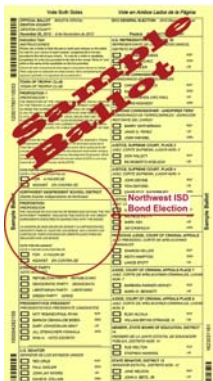

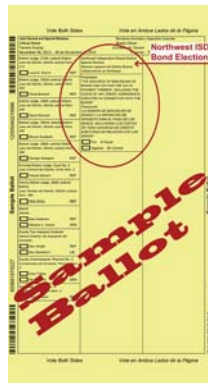
Early Voting Begins Today Election Ballot Includes \$255 Million Bond Referendum for Northwest ISD

Polls open today for the Presidential election and Northwest ISD Bond Referendum. Early voting will continue through November 2. During early voting, residents may vote at any polling location in the county where they reside. On Election Day (November 6), voters must vote at the polling location designated for their precinct. In August, the Northwest ISD Board of Trustees called for a \$255 million capital bond referendum. The bond referendum would provide a new high school, middle school, building additions at existing schools, updates to technology, and safety and security. This bond program is estimated to create more than \$489 million of economic activity for the area.

The Northwest ISD Bond Referendum will be placed in different locations on the election ballot depending on the county. Sample ballots can be viewed on the Northwest ISD Bond Election webpage (www.nisdtx.org/bond2012). The website also contains an overview of projects, history of bond elections, a gallery of photos and videos and specific details on the impact for student's school and feeder zones.

Northwest ISD currently operates 27 separate campuses, spanning three counties (Denton, Tarrant and Wise) and 14 municipalities across 234 square miles. The district welcomed more than 17,800 students this school year and enrolls more than 1,000 students each August.
