Northwest ISD School Board Selected as a Finalist for Outstanding Board

The 2011-2012 Northwest ISD Board of Trustees is one of five school boards in the state selected as an Honor School Board in the Texas Association of School Administrators' (TASA) annual School Board Awards Program.

"I am so proud of our 2011-2012 Board of Trustees for this well-deserved achievement," said Superintendent Karen G. Rue, Ed.D. "This visionary group puts kids first in every decision they make.
