### **Northwest ISD Seeks Recommendations to Rename Agricultural Sciences Learning Center**

The Northwest ISD Board of Trustees and administration invite the community to submit nominations to rename the Agricultural Sciences Learning Center. Beginning May 14 through June 14, community members will have an opportunity to nominate a name for selection. The NISD Agricultural Sciences Center opened in 2003 and is located at the district's central site at 1960 Texan Drive, Justin, 76247.

To be considered, suggestions must meet board policy requirements for naming facilities and shall be named according to one of the following documented categories:

- in memory of a person who has served the district or local NISD community, especially in service to children, and whose virtues or characteristics will serve as role models to students, staff and the community,
- in memory of a person who has made a significant contribution to society and/or education, whose name shall lend prestige and status to an institution of learning,
- a local residential or geographic area
- any state or national heroic figure, landmark and/or historical attributes,
- a district property donor or his/her family members

Facilities other than school buildings shall be named according to the documented categories established for all school buildings. Persons to be so honored by the naming of school buildings and/or facilities shall not be considered while living.

Additional information may be included, such as news clippings, letters of recommendation and/or printed resources that would assist the board in making a decision.

Nominations received through June 14 will be reviewed by a naming selection committee and recommended to the Board. The Board of Trustees will vote on the names at the June 25 school board meeting.
