NISD's Stephanie Espinosa, Ed.D. Named Principal of Lakeview Elementary School

Espinosa began her career in Northwest ISD at Lakeview Elementary School as a classroom instructional teacher in 2007. Her experience spans from the classroom to an assessment specialist to an assistant principal in Fort Worth ISD and Crowley ISD.

"I am excited to return to Lakeview Elementary," Principal Stephanie Espinosa, Ed.D. said. "As a resident of Trophy Club, I'm looking forward to serving the students, staff and community."

Espinosa earned her doctorate in education administration at Nova Southeastern University in May 2013. She holds a master's degree in education administration and a bachelor's degree in elementary education from Texas Christian University. This spring, she was one of 50 Texas principals selected to participate in a cohort of top public school campus leaders at the Harvard Graduate School of Education.
