### **NISD Board of Trustees Approves Attendance Boundaries for New High School**

The attendance boundaries for Northwest ISD's new high school, V.R. Eaton High School were approved at last night's Board of Trustees meeting.

V.R. Eaton High School, which will open in August 2015 in the north Fort Worth/Haslet area, will serve students who live:

- West of Interstate 35W and south of the Tarrant County Line
- The Denton and Wise County portions of the Sendera Ranch Development

Students living in the Haslet Elementary School, Sendera Ranch Elementary School, Thompson Elementary School, Peterson Elementary School, Nance Elementary School, and Schluter Elementary School attendance zones are within the newly created V.R. Eaton High School attendance zone. Students living in the Tarrant County portion of the Seven Hills Elementary School attendance zone will attend V.R. Eaton High School.

The attendance boundary was based on a recommendation by the Northwest ISD administration and a parent advisory committee. Serving on the advisory committee were parents from the following schools: Chisholm Trail and Wilson middle schools, as well as Peterson, Sendera Ranch, Thompson, Haslet, Nance and Schluter elementary schools. A meeting was also held on November 18<sup>th</sup> at Wilson Middle School to present the proposed boundaries to all parents living in the impacted area.

V.R. Eaton High School will open in August 2015 with 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> grades only. Current enrollment projections indicate the school will open with approximately 1,000 students. Another grade level will be added each year until V.R. Eaton High School has 9<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grades in the 2017-18 school year.

V.R. Eaton High School will be the third comprehensive high school in Northwest ISD, a district that continues to experience rapid growth in student enrollment. The campus is named in honor of Wise County resident and rancher V.R. Eaton. Eaton served as a member on the first Northwest ISD school board and assisted in the organization of the district's consolidation.
