Northwest ISD Launches ‘Leadership NISD’ Class of 2014

Leadership NISD, a program created by NISD to promote the vision of the district, develop community leadership, and serve as a resource for community input, held its first meeting this past Wednesday, September 25 at the NISD Administration Building.

“This year’s class has approximately 50 participants,” said Director of Communications Emily Conklin. “Our hope is for each participant to leave feeling more connected to Northwest ISD, with a deeper understanding of our mission, vision and beliefs so they may be an ambassador for public education and Northwest ISD in their communities.”

Leadership NISD is organized into eight monthly meetings running from 7:45 to 9:30 a.m. These meetings will give participants the opportunity to network, and understand the latest developments about the district’s operations and policies.

The objective of Leadership NISD is to involve parents and community members in a year-long dialogue with the school district, allowing participants to get an in-depth behind the scenes look at NISD. Leadership NISD aims to focus specifically on curriculum and instruction, support services, athletics, and school finance, but will be open to discussion of other topics.

Participants who attend at least six sessions will be included in the graduation reception at the May NISD School Board Meeting. Leadership NISD’s next meeting will be held October 23 with a focus on NISD’s nationally recognized communications department, as well as the mission of the Partners in Education program and ways to volunteer and stay connected in NISD.
