NISD's Stephanie Espinosa, Ed.D. Named Executive Director of Curriculum and Staff Development

The NISD Board of Trustees unanimously approved Espinosa's move at the school board meeting on April 14. Espinosa has served students and families in Northwest ISD since 2007. Currently, she is principal at Northwest ISD's Lakeview Elementary School and was the principal of NISD's Seven Hills Elementary School for five years. Her experience spans from the classroom to an assessment specialist to an assistant principal in Fort Worth ISD and Crowley ISD.

“I am excited to serve the students and staff of Northwest ISD in this new role,” said Stephanie Espinosa, Ed.D. “I look forward to collaborating with teachers and principals as we strive to create life-long learners.”

Espinosa earned her doctorate in education administration at Nova Southeastern University in May 2013. She holds a master's degree in education administration and a bachelor's degree in elementary education from Texas Christian University. Last year, she was one of 50 Texas principals selected to participate in a cohort of top public school campus leaders at the Harvard Graduate School of Education. She is also an educational consultant for various school districts in Texas and Oklahoma, training principals and district leaders on school improvement models and standards-based instruction.

Espinosa will finish the school year as principal at Lakeview Elementary School. A new principal will be named before the end of the current school year.

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
