Faris has worked in McKinney ISD as a high school principal and assistant principal, as well as a middle school principal. He additionally serves as an adjunct graduate professor for the College of Education at Dallas Baptist University. Prior to a career in McKinney ISD, he has worked in Center ISD, Nacogdoches ISD, Broaddus ISD and Leggett ISD.

“I am very excited for the opportunity to join the Northwest ISD team,” said Logan Faris, Ed.D. “I am looking forward to providing support to the campuses and district. I have been impressed with all aspects of Northwest ISD, and I’m excited to learn more about the school district and collaborate with the staff and students.”

He earned his doctorate of education in educational leadership, a master’s of education and a bachelor of science from Stephen F. Austin State University. He teaches courses including educational administration and organization, school finance, curriculum design and evaluation and school law and the principalship. Dr. Faris has presented at numerous workshops across the state and nation regarding organizational change, college and career readiness and implementing best practices into schools for administrators. Additionally, he is a board member for the McKinney YMCA and serves as an active member at the First Baptist Church in McKinney.

Faris will immediately begin his transition to Northwest ISD, while fulfilling obligations and graduation commitments to McKinney High School students until the end of the school year.
