### **NISD Names Executive Director of Human Resources**

At the September 23 school board meeting, Superintendent Karen G. Rue, Ed.D. recommended Northwest ISD's Kim Caley as the Executive Director of Human Resources.

Kim Caley is currently the principal at Northwest ISD's Carl E. Schluter Elementary School. Caley opened the campus in 2011 as an America's Choice School. She has worked in Northwest ISD since 1999, serving as a principal and assistant principal at J. Lyndal Hughes Elementary School. She also served as an assistant principal and campus instructional teacher at NISD's Justin Elementary School. Prior to a career in NISD, she worked in Grapevine/Colleyville and Denton ISDs.

"Hiring excellent teachers and staff is critical to the mission of Northwest ISD," said Executive Director of Human Resources Kim Caley. "I am looking forward to working to ensure the human resources department continues to hire and preserve the finest quality educators and support staff to work in Northwest ISD."
