### **NISD's Amy Howell Named Principal of Carl E. Schluter Elementary School**

At the October 28 NISD Board of Trustees meeting, the School Board unanimously approved Amy Howell to take the lead as principal of Carl E. Schluter Elementary School.

“Amy Howell is an excellent recommendation for the Schluter Elementary School principal position,” said Superintendent of Schools Karen G. Rue, Ed.D. “I have seen Ms. Howell advance from a model teacher to an exceptional administrator in Northwest ISD. Amy Howell is currently an assistant principal at Northwest ISD's Chisholm Trail Middle School. She has taught and coached in Northwest ISD since 2004. Previously Howell was an English teacher at NISD's Gene Pike Middle School where she was named the Exemplar Educator of the Year and an NISD Teacher of the Year finalist in 2011-2012. Prior to a career in Northwest ISD, Howell taught and coached in Baton Rouge for two years.

“I am a product of Northwest ISD schools and a proud graduate of Northwest High School,” said Schluter Elementary School Principal Amy Howell. “I am honored to be able to serve as an educator and administrator in this district.”

Amy received her Bachelor of Arts from Louisiana State University and holds a Masters of Education in Education Leadership from Lamar University. She has participated in several NISD Leadership Preparatory Academies and has served as an instructional facilitator and a thinking maps trainer.

“I am looking forward to getting to know the staff, students and parent community at Schluter Elementary School and building upon the excellence already established at this campus,” Howell said.

Howell will begin her new position as principal at Schluter Elementary School in November. She replaces Kim Caley who was named NISD's Executive Director of Human Resources.
