"I am excited to be a part of a school district that strongly aligns with my goals and vision for education," said Chief Technology Officer Adam Feind. "I am eager to meet the staff and build upon the foundation already created in Northwest ISD."

Feind received a bachelor's of business administration in computer information systems from Baylor University. He is a Certified Education Technology Leader (CETL) and is one of 15 technology leaders to hold this certification in the state of Texas. As a member of the Consortium for School Networking (CoSN), a professional association for school district technology leaders, Feind strives to grow tomorrow's leaders through engaging learning environments. Last year, Mr. Feind was instrumental in leading a team from Cisco, along with other school districts, to restore network, telephone, wireless and Internet access to West ISD elementary campuses for staff and students during the West fertilizer explosion.
