### **NISD's V.R. Eaton High School to Host City of Fort Worth Mayor Betsy Price**

- WHAT:** In Northwest ISD, approximately 70% of high school students are enrolled in a career and technical education (CTE) course, with more than 370 competing at the state level. With an emphasis on preparing students for their futures, NISD has invited City of Fort Worth Mayor Betsy Price to tour the district's newest comprehensive high school and see first-hand what students are doing to prepare for their paths ahead.

- WHY:** In August 2015, Eaton High School opened its doors in Fort Worth welcoming approximately 1,000 freshman and sophomore students. Located in one of the fastest growing areas in NISD, Eaton is situated in the Willow Springs housing development and serves students from Fort Worth, Newark and Haslet. The campus will add a grade level each year until it serves ninth through twelfth grade students in the 2017-2018 school year. The campus was funded through the passing of the 2012 bond referendum.
- Northwest ISD's vision is to be the best and most sought-after school district where ever student is future ready: ready for college, ready for the global workplace and ready for personal success. During the tour, Mayor Price will be provided with an overview of the CTE program in Northwest ISD and visit classrooms where she will hear personal learning experiences from students focusing on family consumer science, agricultural science, broadcast, architectural design, health science technology and computer science.
- Eaton High School is also home to the district's Academy of Business Management and Entrepreneurship and the Academy of Aviation and Aeronautics (opening in the fall of 2016).
