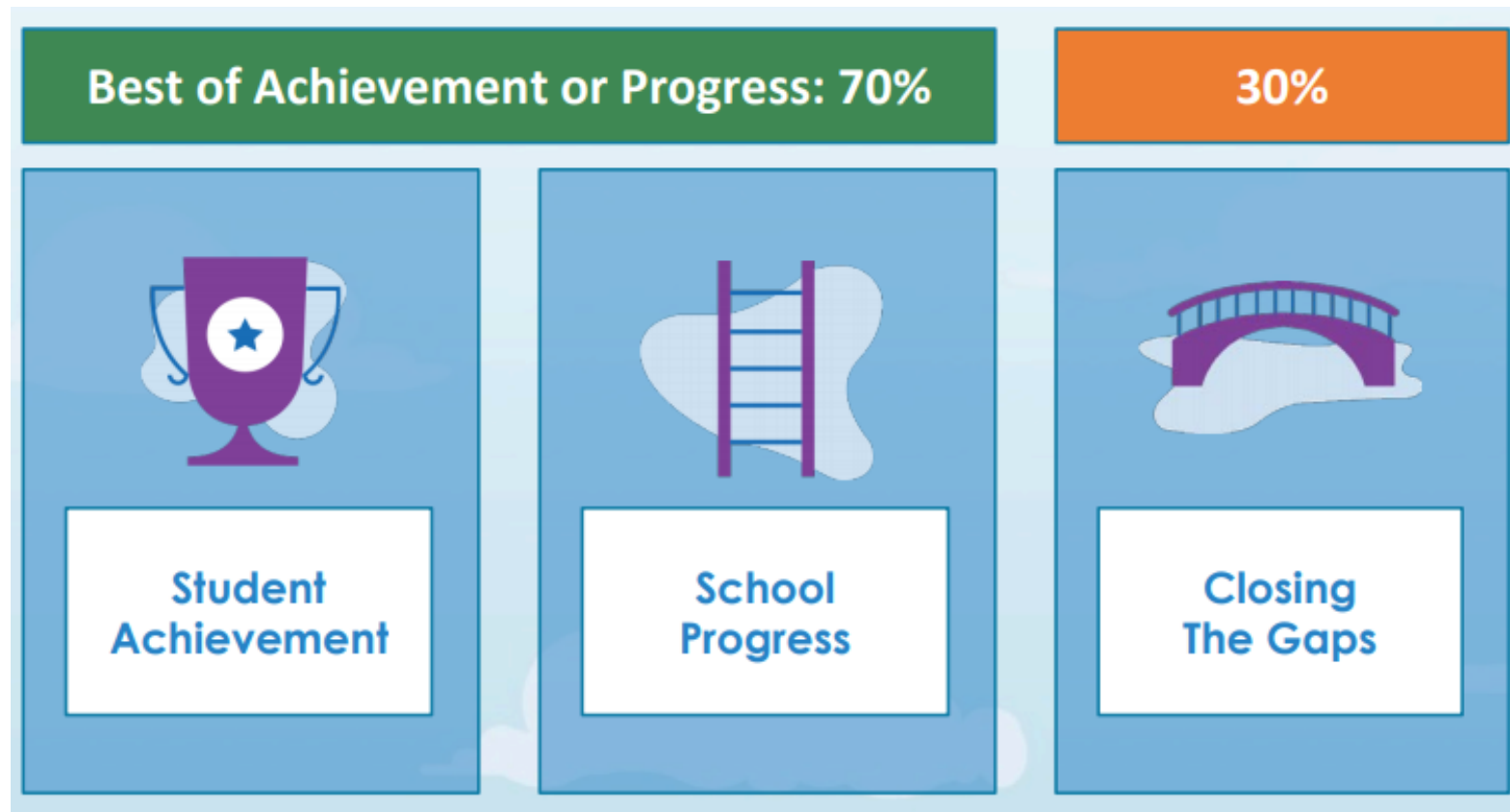

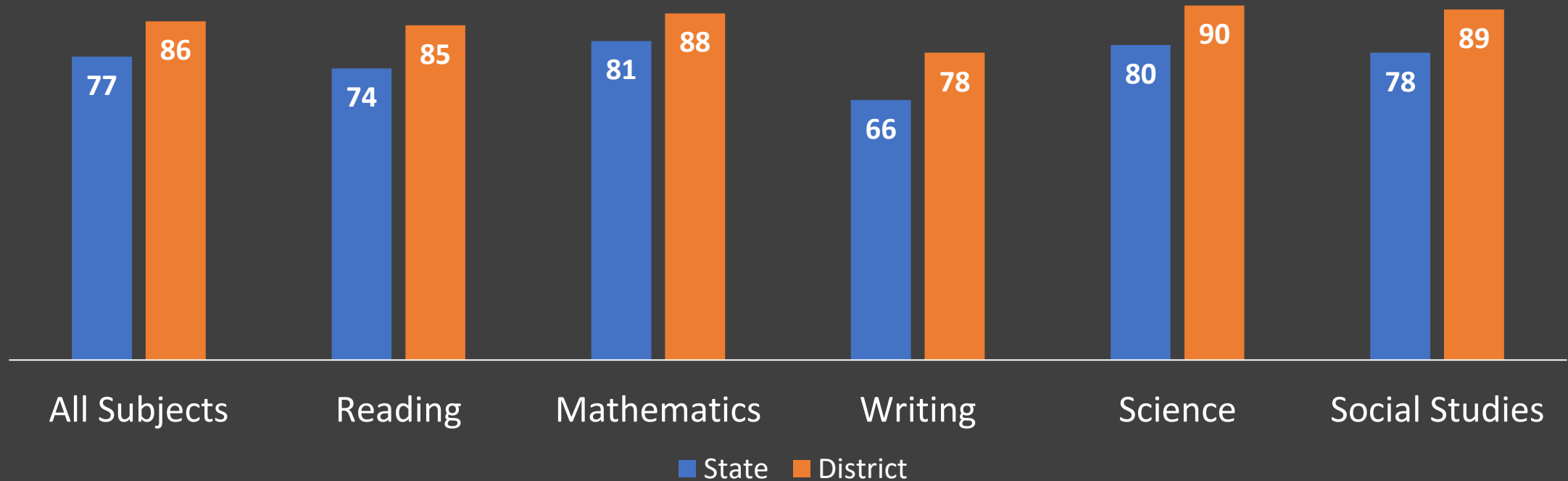

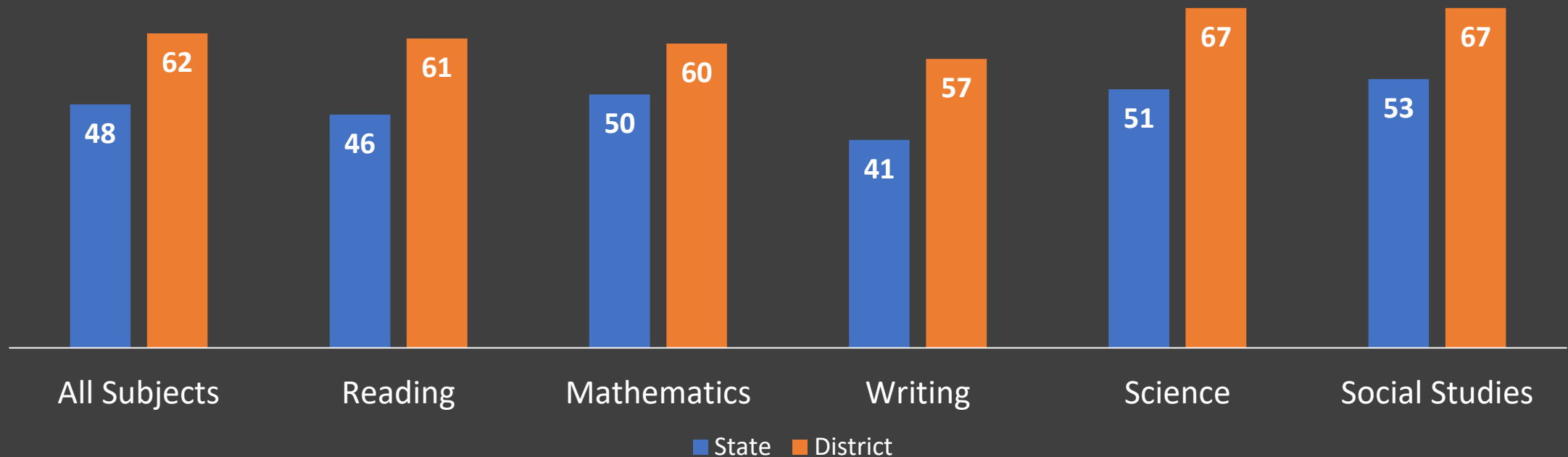

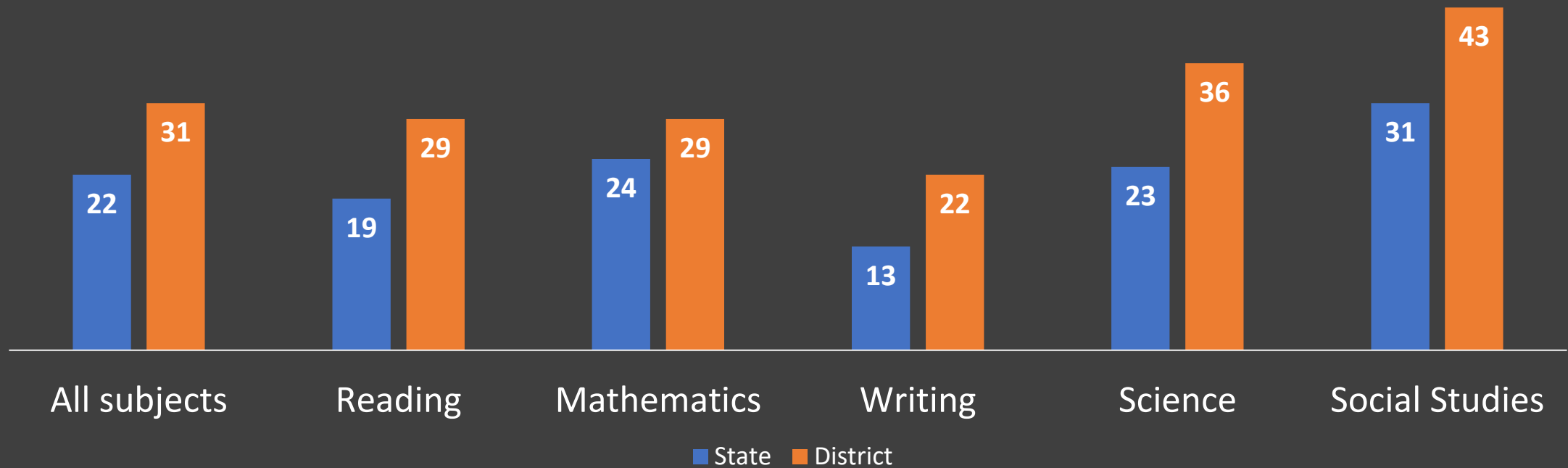
2018 state and district comparison percent of students passing at “approaches” level.



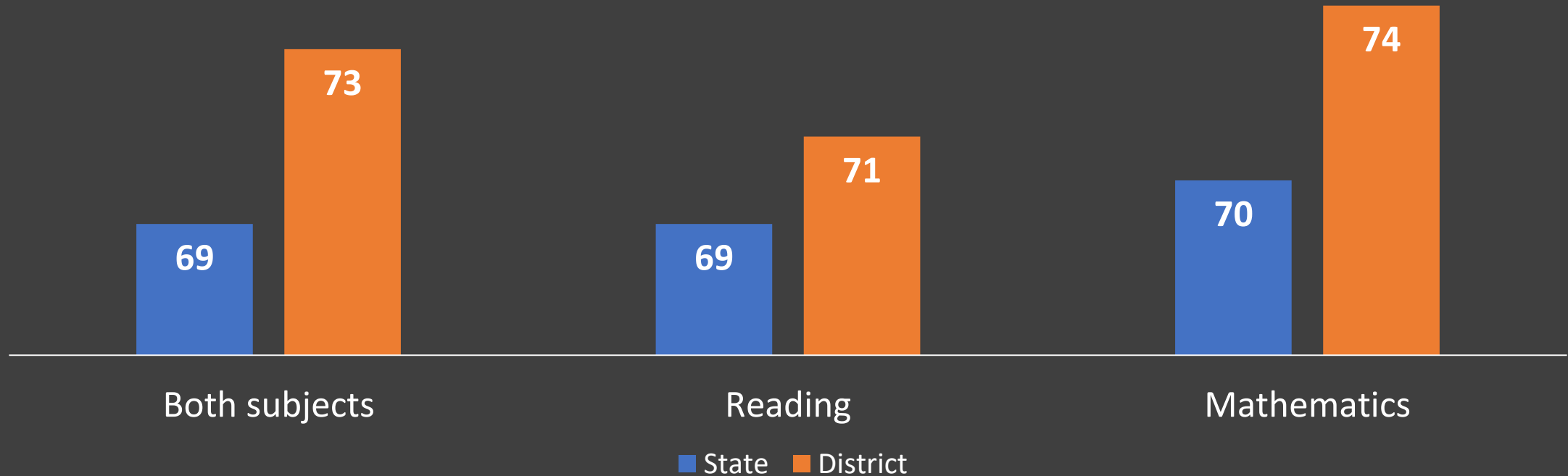
2018 state and district comparison percent of students passing at “meets” level.



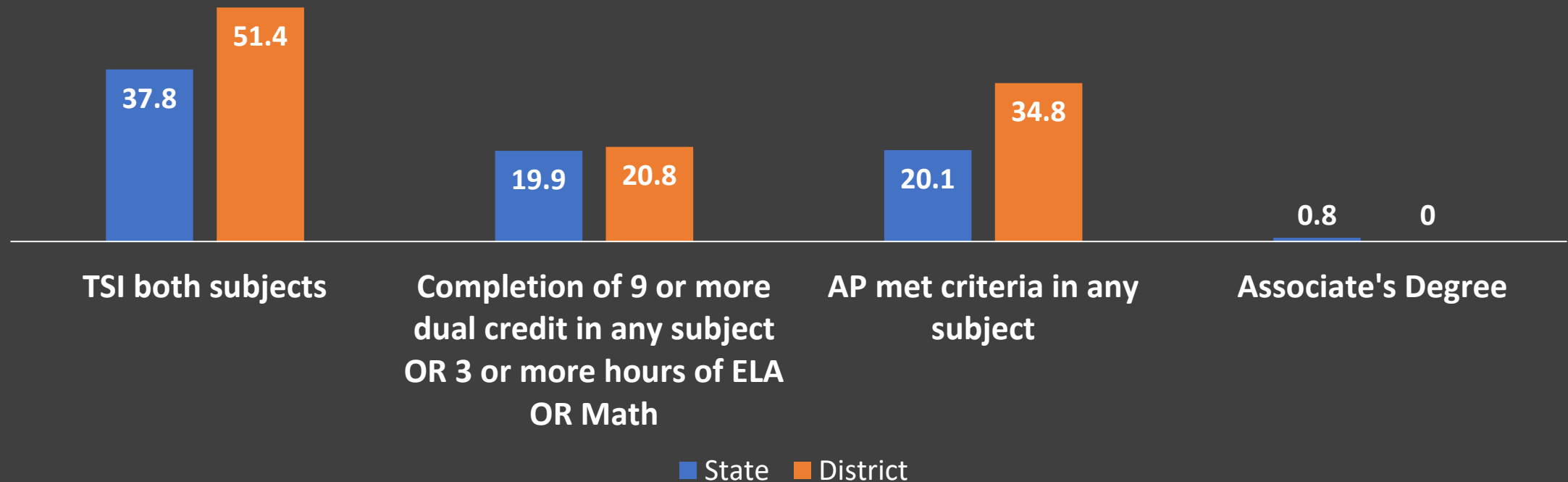
2018 state and district comparison percent of students passing at “masters” level.



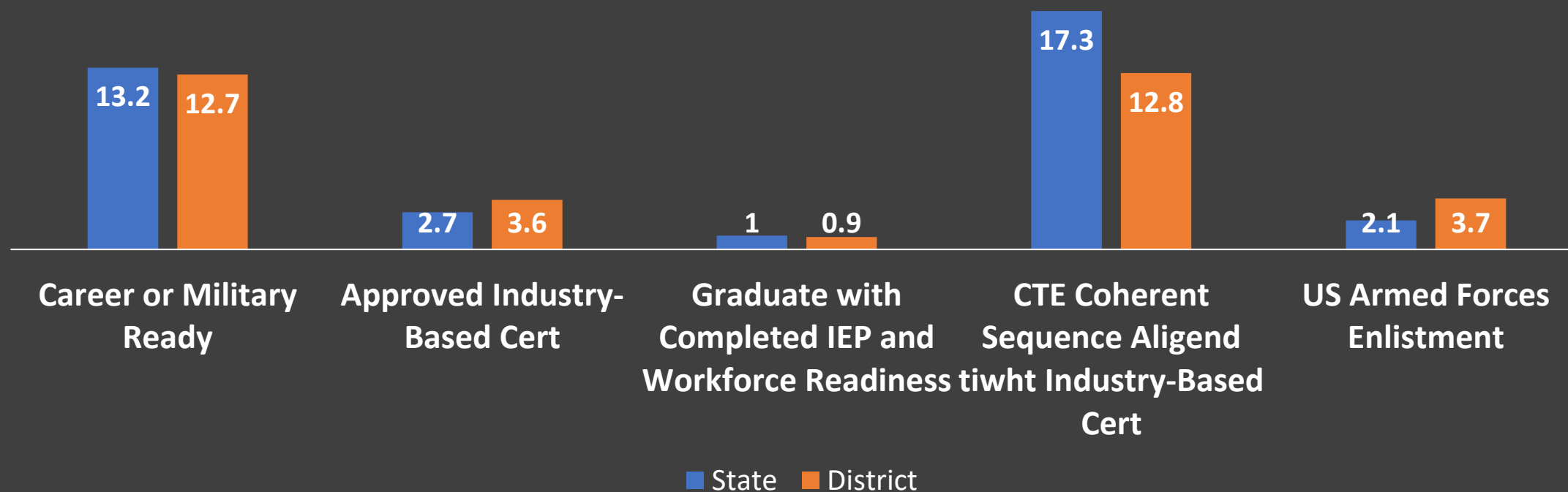
2018 state and district comparison percent of students gaining progress on year over year STAAR tests.



College-Readiness Indicators 2017 Graduates



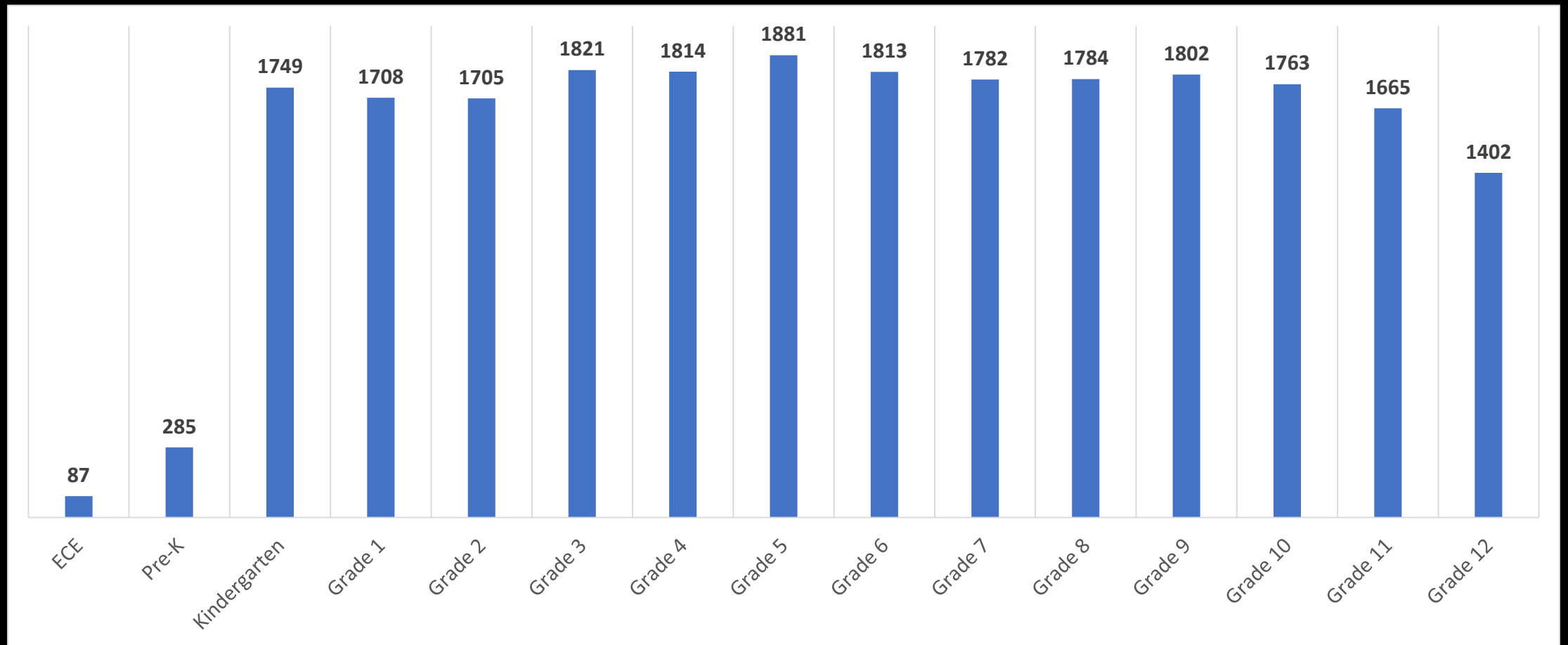

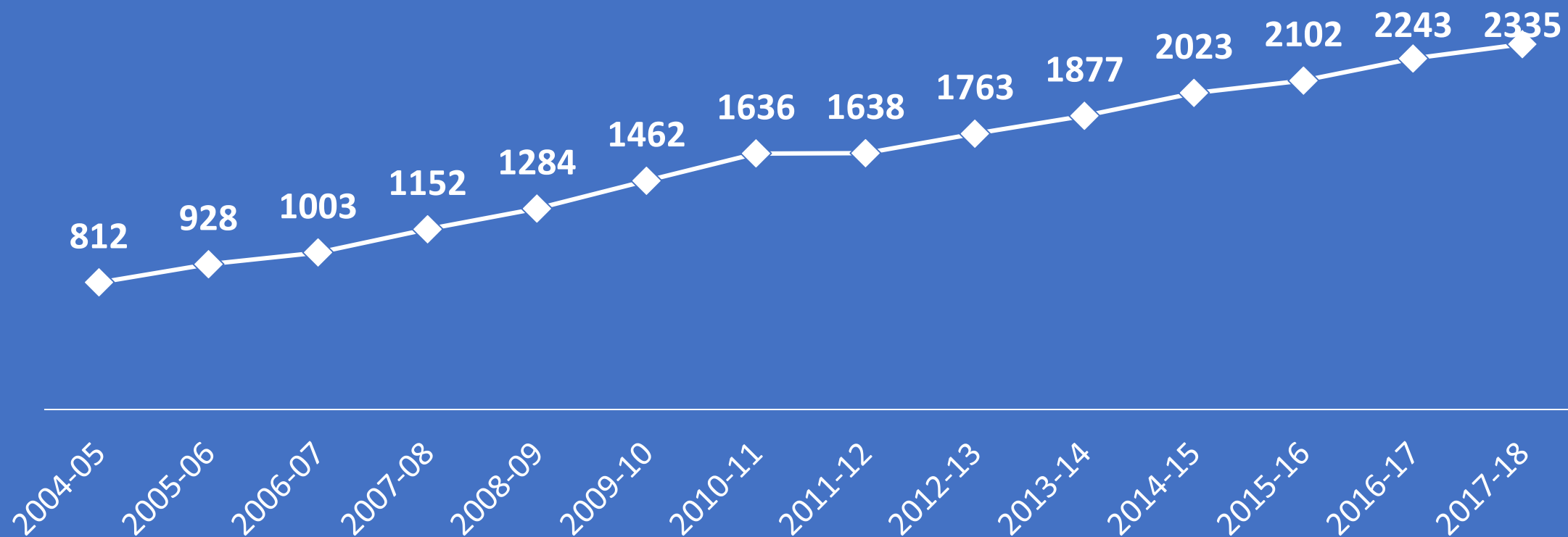
